Pick Up and Drop Off Procedures

In today's family envelope you will find map of our pick up and drop off procedure as a reminder. This system is designed to keep all children safe in our parking lot. Here are a couple areas for focus.

- In the morning, please only use the front parking lot if you need to park and come into the school with your student(s). With lots of cars backing out, it is not safe to drop your student off at the front doors without accompanying them in.
- To drop off your student, please use the drive through area in the north parking lot by the buses and drop them off near the stairway. Thank you for understanding that although this takes a few more minutes, it is worth it to keep our children safe.
- Please do not drop your children off before the doors open at 8:10. We have no adult supervision outside before 8:10. If you need to drop your child off before 8:10, please send them down the breezeway to before care.
- In the afternoon, please line up according to the map. Wait patiently for the line to move. Please do not jump ahead of other cars in line.
- When you are in the pick-up line, please remain in your vehicle at all times. If you need to exit your vehicle for any reason, please pull into a parking spot.

Thank you so much for your attention to these details. It helps everyone if we follow a safe procedure for delivering and picking up our precious students.
