## Family Envelopes

## Pick-Up and Drop-Off

Unless you are walking your student into the school in the mornings for grades 1-10, we ask that you drive through our drop off line on the north end of the school back by the playground area.

For afternoon pick up at the front of the school we need to reserve the first line closest to the school for our preschool pick up from 2:45 - 3:00. The parents need to sign their students out, so it does take a little time. If you arrive before 3:00 please use the 2nd line to wait in.

#### **Individual Pictures**

Parson's Photography will be here Wednesday, September 18th to take individual student photos. These will be used for the yearbook, student records, ASB cards, etc. Parents have the option to order packets of photos and ASB cards, and a variety of options are available as well. You will find picture forms in your family envelope today. Each student will need to have their own packet with a separate check made payable to Parsons or exact change cash enclosed.

Note to Parents: Some area public schools require middle school students to have an ASB card to gain entry to events. If you would like your student to have an ASB card from our school, please note this on your envelope and enclose an additional \$5.00.

#### **Primetime Care Rate**

For the convenience of our parents and the safety of our students, before school care is offered from 7:10am-8:10am and after school care is offered from 3:15-5:15 PM. There is a \$5.00 hourly charge per child for this service (1/2 hour minimum) billed to you at the end of the month. All students who arrive at school before 8:10am or who have not been picked up by 3:15pm will be sent to Prime Time Care. Students may not wait unsupervised anywhere on the campus, so to avoid before or after school care charges, parents should arrange to have their student dropped off no earlier than 8:10am and picked up by 3:15pm. Prime Time Care will not be available after school on early release days.
