## Safety at CCS

We are learning together as we complete the first day of school. We are committed to keeping our facility sanitized according to guidelines. There are so many facets to consider regarding sanitizing and keeping your children safe. We are addressing issues as they arise. If you see something we are overlooking, please don't hesitate to let us know. After parent orientation Monday night, a few modifications have been made.

- 1. In second grade we will be sending a cousin of Douglas, their classroom mascot, home with students this year. Cousin Douglas is not a stuffed animal. Rather he has a hard surface covering which we can easily sanitize when he returns to school each week. We still love our stuffed Douglas, but he will be in hiding for the next few months.
- 2. Students will be bringing books home from the school library or their classroom's library. Please know these books have been untouched by students before being checked out. When students return their books, they will be kept out of circulation for 3 days before being returned to the shelf. This follows appropriate guidelines for Covid safety.

## **Tree Nut Allergy**

We have a student with a severe allergic reaction to tree nuts. Please be careful when sending food containing nuts or peanuts to school with your children. This doesn't mean your child cannot eat nuts at school. Rather we need to be aware that they don't share them with others. Thanks for your understanding.
